Narrative						
<i>On Thursday, December 4, 2020, at approximately 2052 hours, I, Officer Dudley along with Officer King responded to 1515 Ashland Springs Way in reference to an assault. Upon arrival, Officers spoke to Mrs. Sharon Jones (Victim/Complainant) along with Mr. Daniel Jones (Witness/Other) at the end of the street. Mrs. Jones stated her and the witness were at 1515 Ashland Springs Way to serve civil paperwork on Mr. Scott Davis (Suspect/Arrestee) due to his company being sued. Mrs. Jones stated her and the witness gave the suspect the paper work. Mrs. Jones further stated her and the witness went back to their vehicle to leave the residence and stated the suspect came to their vehicle, opened the door and this caused Mrs. Jones dog to come from the back of the vehicle and the suspect struck the dog with his fist and stated "if I ever see you all again, i'll kill you" the suspect then threatened to shoot Mrs. Jones and Mr. Jones, struck the dog again and then struck Mrs. Jones on the left eye. I did observe a mark on the victim's left eye consistent with this statement. Officers went to the residence to speak with the suspect. Upon our arrival, the suspect seen officers pull up, stepped outside, went back inside and locked the door. I knocked on the door and announced "Sheriff's Office" attempting to make contact with the suspect, and I watched the suspect retrieve a shotgun through the glass window portion of the door, in fear for my life and safety as well as Officer Kings life and safety, I immediately pulled my County issued firearm and pointed it at the suspect and gave him verbal commands to drop the gun. Officers ordered the suspect over 10 times to drop his weapon, to which he stated "What are you doing here? Fuck you, Drop your fucking guns, This is my fucking house" and then stated he was calling the Sheriff right now. Officers finally convinced the suspect to put the weapon away, but refused commands to step away from it. Officers directed him to step down the stairs away from the gun and he stated "Fuck you all, I don't have to do anything" and yelled "Shoot me." Officers attempted to detain the suspect for our safety and he resisted arrest by pulling away and not giving his hands to officers. After a brief struggle, officers were able to restrain the suspect. I observed a strong odor of alcohol emitting from the suspect, as well as him stating he had consumed three beers. Officers contacted the magistrate in reference to the call and was advised to contact Assistant District Attorney Judd Davis who was made aware of the situation and charges. Mr. Davis was taken into custody and transported to the Roger D. Wilson detention facility for booking. Mrs. Jones injuries were documented with the Axon Capture app. Officer King later received a message from the victim stating she was having difficulty seeing and was at the Hospital to be checked out, she also advised she</i>
